

How to activate my .TEL domain?

Use your .TEL domains

To set up TelHosting for your .TEL domains you need a username and password to log into your account on the TelHosting interface. These login credentials are available through your EPAG web panel.

Please follow these steps to activate TelHosting for your .TEL domain:

1. Log into <https://domrob.epag.net> using your EPAG login credentials.
2. Browse to "Domains" and go to "View/Edit domains".
3. Search your desired .TEL domain, and click onto the domain name to open a detailed view of the domain data.

4. In the "Other parameters" section, the TelHosting login credentials for this domain will be displayed as "TelHosting username" and "TelHosting password".



5. Now use these login credentials to log into your TelHosting account on the TelHosting portal at <https://www.telhosting.de>. After you have logged in, you may add contact information and additional data for .TEL domain names.

The creation of TelHosting login credentials will be possible only after the TelHosting service has been started, so login credentials might be available only with some delay after the TelHosting launch. As soon as login access data have been created, they will be available as explained above.

One set of login credentials will be created for each registrant contact of a .TEL domain name. If a single registrant has registered multiple .TEL domain names, TelHosting management for all of these domains will be available through this single login.
